## **CROCHETED COTTON BIB**

**Finished size:** about 8 inches x 8 inches for body of bib; 12 inches for length of strap

### **Materials:**

Crochet Hook: Size J

Yarn: Approximately 75 yards of cotton yarn

### **Directions:**

#### **Body of Bib**

Chain 30.

**Row 1:** 1 sc in 4 ch from hook (counts as ch-1 sp and 1 sc), \*ch 1, skip next ch, 1 sc in next ch, rep from \* across. Turn.

**Row 2:** ch 2 (counts as ch-1 sp), \*work 1 sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, rep from \* across, work 1 sc in sp of turning ch. Turn.

**Row 3+:** Repeat Row 2 until bib length equals bib width (around 8 inches). Turn.

Do not fasten off.

#### **Strap of Bib**

Ch 2, \*work 1 sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, 1 sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, 1 sc in next ch-1 sp\* (3 sc in row of strap). Turn.

Continue working each row (with 3 sc in the row) until strap measures about 12 inches.

Fasten off.

**Variations:**

Add an optional border with the same yarn or a contrasting color.

- a. **SIMPLE:** Single crochet in each stitch across the top. Fasten off.
- b. **PICOT:** Single crochet into first stitch near hook, chain 3. Single crochet into next two stitches. Repeat across top. Fasten off.

**Finishing:**

Weave in all ends.

Sew snap on the end of the strap and on the body of the bib.

Add decorative button or applique, if desired.

**Bless your completed project with a hug and your love.** It will provide comfort, healing, and hope for the recipient.
