## **EASY KNIT BOOTIES**

Adapted from a free Bundles of Love pattern available on Ravelry.

**Finished size:** The foot of the bootie should be at least 3 inches long.

### **Materials:**

Needles: Size suggested on yarn wrapper or a size to achieve the suggested measurement

Yarn: Soft baby, DK or worsted weight

### **Directions:**

Cast on 28 sts. Knit 10 rows. This part should be at least 6 inches wide to make the foot of the bootie at least 3 inches long.

Row 11: K12, K2 tog, K2 tog, K12

Row 12: Knit across

Row 13: K11, K2 tog, K2 tog, K11

Row 14: Knit across

Row 15: K10, K2 tog, K2 tog, K10

Row 16: Knit across. You should have 22 sts

Rib these sts for 12 rows, K1,P1 or K2,P2.

Cast off in ribbing.

**Finishing:** Fold finished bootie in half and sew the center back seam and sole closed. Weave in all yarn ends.

**Bless your completed project with a hug and your love.** It will provide comfort, healing, and hope for the recipient.
