## **EASY CROCHET BOOTIES**

This pattern was created for Knitting4Peace by Joan Richardson Interfaith Peace Pod, Denver, CO

**NOTE:** These booties are crocheted in one piece (from the sole to the cuff), folded in half, and sewn together.

**Finished size:** The bootie should be at least 3 inches long.

## **Materials:**

Hook: Size H Yarn: Baby yarn

Tapestry or yarn needle for weaving in ends

#### **Directions:**

slip stitches here

#### **BODY OF EACH BOOTIE:**

Row 10

### Chain 25.

**Row 1**: Half double crochet (hdc) in second chain from hook and in each chain across. Chain 2 and turn.

**Row 2:** Hdc in each stitch across row. Ch 2 and turn.

**Row 3:** Hdc in each stitch across row. Ch 2 and turn.

**Row 4:** Hdc in each stitch across row. Ch 2 and turn.

**Row 5:** Hdc in each stitch across row. Leave off chain 2 at end. TURN and slip stitch 5 times. Chn 3 in fifth stitch (counts as one half double crochet and one chain).

**Row 6:** Hdc in next stitch and \*Ch 1, leaving the following stitch empty. Hdc in next stitch and repeat 5 times from \*.

- Leave the last 4 stitches unworked. You should end with a half double crochet.
- Ch 2 and turn.

**Row** 7: Hdc in each stitch across top. Ch2 and turn.

**Row 8:** Hdc in each stitch across top. Ch 2 and turn.

**Row 9:** Hdc in each stitch across top. Ch 2 and turn.

**Row 10:** Hdc in each stitch across top. Fasten off or begin edging.

**Edging:** Do not fasten off. Turn (and change colors if you wish) and crochet your choice of edging.

- **RUFFLE:** In first stitch near hook 1 sc, 2 dc, 1 sc. \*Sl st into following stitch, then in next stitch 1 sc, 2 dc, 1 sc.\* Repeat from \* across top until end. Fasten off and weave in ends.
- **PICOT:** Single crochet into first stitch near hook, ch 3. SC into next two stitches. Repeat across top. Fasten off and weave in ends.
- **SIMPLE:** Sc in each stitch across the top. Fasten off and weave in ends.

#### Finishing:

- Fold in half with right sides together. Stitch together on the wrong side along the sole, toe and cuff (leaving the top open). Turn bootie right side out.
- Weave in all ends.

Bless your completed project with a hug and your love. It will provide comfort, healing, and hope for the recipient.
