## CROCHET FUR STITCH FUN SCARF

Pattern from Darlene Danyo, Highlands Ranch CO Peace Pod

**NOTE:** Darlene says, "It's easier than it looks!!"

<u>Finished size:</u> About 7" by 54". You can increase or decrease the length of the scarf by follow the pattern until the scarf is the desired length. You can increase the width of the scarf by casting on more stitches in multiples of 2.

## **Materials:**

Hook: Size specified on yarn wrapper

Yarn: Soft, warm, washable worsted weight yarn

## **Directions:**

Make a chain of at least 7".

Row 1: Dc in fourth chain from hook, then dc in each ch stitch. Ch 1, turn

Row 2: Sc in front strand only (not in both top strands as usual) of the first dc below, \*Ch 5, sc in front strand (also called loop) of next dc\*. Repeat from \* to \* across ending with last sc in top of ch-3. Ch 3 (counts as first dc of Row 3) Turn.

Row 3. Folding Row 2 back out of the way, skip ch 3 below first sc, then work a DC in the unworked top strand(loop) of each remaining stitch of Row 1. ch 1, turn.

Repeat rows 2 and 3 for fur stitch pattern, working number of rows to achieve desired length. Fasten off.

The front side will have loops, while the back side will be smooth.

**Finishing:** Weave in all ends.

Bless your completed project with a hug and your love. It will provide comfort, healing, and hope for the recipient.
